GRADUATION RATE DISCLOSURE

Westminster College is pleased to provide detailed information regarding our graduation rates. The information is provided in compliance with Section 485(a)(1)(Q) of the Higher Education Act (HEA) of 1965, as amended.

Graduation rate measures the rate of first-time, full-time, degree seeking undergraduate students who graduate within 150% of normal time. At Westminster College this 150% measure describes students graduating from a four-year program within six years. In Fall 2017 there were 174 first-time, full-time, degree seeking undergraduate students who entered Westminster College. After 6 years (as of August 31, 2023), 57% of these students had graduated from our institution.
