At this time, Westminster College plans to open its physical campus for activities and classes beginning with Commencement 2020 on Aug. 8. Meanwhile, while a few staff members continue to work remotely this summer, many staff members returned to campus on May 18, implementing recommended health and social-distancing measures.

As of June 1, we are happy to report that by employing a number of careful health and safety precautions, prospective students and their families are allowed to visit campus on a limited basis. Please refer to this resource if you are interested in visiting Westminster College.

Please keep in mind that although our campus is beginning to open, the safety of our Blue Jays continues to be foremost in our decision making, and we consistently monitor the COVID-19 situation throughout our area and worldwide.
