In assessing the current escalating Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) situation throughout the world, particularly in the state of Missouri, I have made the difficult decision to continue online delivery of all courses through the end of the semester. Online classes through our Digital Blue Distance Learning Plan will begin as scheduled on March 23 and end with the official last day of classes on May 7.

Please note that Westminster's COVID-19 Task Force has established careful procedures for the future controlled removal of student belongings from campus, which will involve restricted access to campus and take place at a later date.
