

CAMPUS VISITORS & TOUR GUIDELINES — JUNE 1, 2020

We are excited to announce the limited reopening of our beautiful campus in Fulton, MO, as we will be scheduling campus tours for prospective students. Given that our campus remains closed with limited access, campus visitors must contact the office of Enrollment, Athletic Department, and/or Campus Security to gain access to facilities. Health and safety continue to be our top priority; therefore, we have implemented vigorous cleaning/sanitization, facility preparation, and the following guidelines to protect our campus community as well as visitors to Westminster College:

- Please stay home and check our virtual tour option if you or your guests are ill, have come into contact with someone who has COVID-19, or have the following symptoms: fever, coughing, shortness of breath, respiratory symptoms, chills, muscle pain, sore throat, or loss of taste or smell, as these may be related to COVID-19.
- All guests must check in with Security by either calling 573-592-5555 or by
 providing contact information to your campus representative (i.e. Enrollment or
 Athletics). If you have completed the online scheduling/check-in, your information
 will be shared with Security in order for us to track all campus visitors at this time.
- Masks or other face coverings are optional and a personal preference; therefore, if you would like to wear one during your visit, please bring a mask, or a mask will be provided for you.
- Practice social distancing and adhere to the 6-feet distance rule to protect yourself and those you come into contact with.

At Westminster, we value our relationships and connections with others. We would love to shake your hand or high-five you for the great decision to tour Westminster, but at this time, we will be respectful of social-distancing guidelines. Please know we are very excited to meet you and show our exceptional campus we call home.

- Please limit the number of guests and/or family members during your in-person tour, as we are limiting gatherings to no more than 10 people. This practice ensures adequate social distancing.
- Bring hand sanitizer or use the sanitizing stations throughout campus, and make sure to use recommended handwashing practices.
